Please bring on first day of Camp:

- * Signed release form from parent or Legal Guardian.
Please note that campers will not be allowed access to horses unless the camp has this form.
- * Balance of camp fee if not already paid in full
- * Change of clothes in a bag labeled with the campers full name. Items will be returned on last day of camp. (Shirt, socks, undergarments, pants)
- * Any medications that camper may need. In a small paper sack labeled with campers full name.
- * Sunblock. Please label with campers full name.

Please bring each day of Camp:

- * Well fitted paddock boots or boots with heels. (rubber boots will not be acceptable).
Boots must be worn each day while working around the horses.
- * Please wear long pants, preferably jeans.
- * Sack lunch, drinks and morning & afternoon snack.

Recommended Items (But not required)

- * Well-fitted equine activity approved helmet. The camp does have a limited number of helmets that are shared among our campers. Campers must wear a helmet when mounted.
- * Sneakers for non-riding activities.
- * Sunglasses.

Please have your camper arrive on time and ready to go. We have lots of activities planned each day and there will be a lot to accomplish in the week.

On Friday afternoon of your camper's secession parents, relatives and friends are invited to watch their camper perform a Mounted Exhibition and watch their camper receive awards.

Directions to Painted Valley Farms

From Silverdale/Poulsbo/Bainbridge Island: Take Highway 307 (Bond Road) towards Kingston. The entrance to Painted Valley is approximately 3+ miles on the left hand side. You will pass the Stottlemeyer/Gunderson intersection and Sawdust Hill Road on the left. There will be a large clearing on the left with pastures and an arena. There is a Painted Valley Farms sign at the entrance, turn left on the gravel driveway. Please go up and over the hill to the barn and parking lot, there will be camp counselors waiting.

From Kingston/Hansville: Take Highway 307 (Bond Road) towards Poulsbo. You will pass Port Gamble Road on the right and Stottlemeyer on the right. After cresting the large hill on Bond Road you will see a clearing on the right and a Painted Valley Farms sign at the entrance, turn right on the gravel driveway. Please go up and over the hill to the barn and parking lot, there will be camp counselors waiting.
